IMPORTANT: The Walk to Emmaus is not an Evangelistic tool or a place to solve deep emotional problems. The candidate you are sponsoring needs to be an active, believing Christian, hopefully a leader or "leader in waiting." Emmaus is a vehicle for Christian renewal within the church. I will bring the Candidate to Big Canyon Ranch on Thursday at 6:30 PM MT. I will attend Sponsor's Hour, Candlelight, Closing, and take the Candidate home after Closing. I will also wee to the needs of the Candidate's family during the weekend. After the weekend I will help the Candidate get into a 4th Day Group as well as assist the Candidate to get connected iw6h our community, and finally, educate the Candidate on Sponsorship. The Candidate does not, to my knowledge, have any physical, mental, or spiritual problem that would hinder his/her experience or the experience of others during the weekend.

The costs to attend the Walk to Emmaus Weekend have increased because we have moved the Walk to a more comfortable conference center with beds, showers, and catered meals. We believe this will enable us to attract even more Candidates to the Walk. However, our managing principle is that money should not be an obstacle to any worker or Candidate attending the Walk. In God's economy we understand that everything we have belongs to the Lord and we are but His stewards. The Lord has already provided! Please do not let money keep you from sponsoring a Candidate. SPONSOR'S FINANCIAL COMMITMENT:

- The cost to sponsor a candidate is **\$210**, or **\$175** if you are working the walk full-time
- We encourage you to invite other Emmaus friends in your congregation to help share this sponsorship cost
- This cost can be reduced for you, or other members of your family attending the Walk in the following Guidelines:
 - The cost for a second person from your family to attend is \$175. The third person can attend for **\$150**
 - The actual cost for each person attending is **\$210** (**\$175** for the Sponsor and **\$35** for the Candidate)
 - Scholarships are available. All you need to do is ask our Registrar/Treasurer know if you need a scholarship

Your Candidate will be asked to leave all electronic devices, and watches, at home or to secure them with you. Please reinforce this message. Emergency contact will be provided.

Let your Candidate know to bring the following items:

- Bible
 - Notebook
 - Pen
 - Devotional material you use
 - Sleeping bag or twin sheets, blankets pillow and pillow case
 - Towel, washcloth and personal toiletries
 - Medications that are needed
 - Casual, comfortable clothing
 - Warm jacket (it may be cool in the evening and we can't predict the weather)
 - Comfortable, closed-toe shoes or boots
 - Water bottle
 - Flashlight
 - Sunglasses
 - Hat and umbrella (in case it rains)
